Comprehensive IIT

About the Course

IIT-JEE is considered to be the toughest entrance examination in India because unpredicted and unexpected types of questions are asked in it. This is one of the core factors that discourages the students to appear at IIT-JEE but such students are very much inclined to appear at AIEEE and other state level entrance Examinations. But this comprehensive course for IIT has been planned and designed by PTPL in such a manner that it safe guards the interest of the aspirant to appear at the IIT-JEE examination in addition to that it paves an easy way to appear at AIEEE and other state level entrance examinations. The duration of the course is for one year and the comprehensive syllabus has been prepared taking the common portion from AIEEE and IIT. The synchronised course is taught during this period on course to course basis and advance level studies is given equal importance and the entire programme is monitored through Ex-IIT'ans . The entire course has been designed adjusting that in three cycles.

During **Cycle-1** : The basic and conceptual study is given importance. Advance level studies are made during the **Cycle-2**. The **Cycle-3** is purely a reversionary practice cycle. The test programmes with the course are also very much beneficial. Weekly Assignment test (WAT) are conducted in the style and pattern of AIEEE in every week. Monthly Assignment Test (MAT) are conducted at the end of every month according to pattern of IIT-JEE. Every faculty takes daily test in each and every class. The target Test Series for AIEEE and IIT-JEE starts from Cycle-2 and ends with the coimpletion of syllabus. During Cycle-3 a series of mock test are arranged for AIEEE and IIT-JEE. Students are supplied study material in the books from, five in each subjects of studies and there by an aspirant gets

fifteen books in addition to that fifteen basic assignment per subject and 15 advance assignment per subject are also given as the study material.

CYCLE - 1

Commences from June/July to Nov.

- ◆ Emphasis is given on basic level conceptual classes for IIT-JEE and AIEEE as per syllabus, through faculties comprising only Ex-IIT'ans.
- ◆ Increased number of doubt clearing classes and counseling sessions.
- ◆ Teaching through printed study booklet (15-books in total)
- ◆ Topic wise basic Assignment (45-in total)
- ◆ Weekly Assignment Test (WAT) in each subject (topic wise) as per the style and Pattern of AIEEE.
- ◆ Monthly Assignment Test (MAT) in cumulative syllabus is held at the end of every month as per the style and pattern of IIT-JEE.
- ◆ Every day 4&1/2 hours of class.
- ◆ 6 day's Classes in a weak.
- ◆ Daily test and appraisal in every class.

CYCLE - 2

Commences from Dec. to Feb.

- ◆ Advance level study and revisionary classes by Ex-IIT'ans.
- ◆ Practice sessions based on advance Assignments (45 in total) by Ex-IIT'ans.
- ◆ Weekly Assignment Test (WAT) for AIEEE.
- ◆ Monthly Assignment Test (MAT) for IIT-JEE.
- ◆ Target to AIEE test series (15 test) in each subject.
- ◆ Daily test and appraisal in every class.

- ◆ Increased number of doubt clearing class-counseling sessions by teaching faculties.
- ◆ 6 days in a week and each day 4 hours class.

CYCLE - 3

Commences from March to April

- ◆ Systematic revision and doubt clearing sessions by teaching faculties.
- ◆ Balance test and appraisal of target to AIEEE.
- ◆ Balance test of Target to test series IIT-JEE and its appraisal analysis.
- ◆ Mock Test and appraisal for IIT-JEE and AIEEE.
- ◆ Test Analysis class by Ex-IIT'ans.
- ◆ 6 day's in a week with every day 6 hours class (Approx.) in each day.
